

Student Acceleration Application Form



Students attending St Louis de Montfort's should progress to the next year level with their peers. When a request to consider acceleration (skipping a year of schooling) for students attending school from Foundation to Year 10 is received, a Program Support Group (PSG) meeting must be convened to consider all the available information and any additional adjustments that could be made to the student's current educational program. A collaborative approach should be taken to review the student's needs and identify other educational options/strategies and supports that the school could offer e.g., subject based acceleration, mentoring, access to VCE subjects, etc.

In exceptional situations where students are identified as gifted (IQ at or above 130) and when considered in their best interest, schools may request that a student is granted an exemption to accelerate a year level.

When considering if a student may benefit from skipping a year level, the PSG should consider the student's best interests, including factors such as the student's age, academic performance, gifted ability, maturity, social ability and emotional wellbeing, attitude, peer group support and dependence. A cognitive assessment is required, and independent, expert advice is to be sought, if necessary, from consultants or health or allied health professionals to confirm giftedness.

Research about year-level acceleration should also be considered.

Following close examination of all factors, and when the principal considers that year-level acceleration is in the student's best interest, the completed application form should be forwarded to the regional general manager by the principal.

This application should be completed by the Program Support Group, supported by the parent/guardian/carers in consultation with relevant professionals, and provided to the principal. Where the principal determines that skipping a year of school is in the best interests of the student, this form should be submitted to the regional general manager.

In Victoria, compulsory schooling is from 6 to 17 years. St Louis de Montfort's caters for students aged 5–12 years
